



IMAGINE Children's Health Center Disaster Policy

It is the policy of IMAGINE Children's Health Center to establish procedures to be followed prior to a pending event, during or after an event that causes operational disruption. Employees, volunteers, contract labor, Board of Directors, and/or students may be called upon to provide labor assistance, donations, or materials at their respective fees for protective measures, labor, equipment, prevention, clean-up, replacement, repair, and if displaced, renewal of operations in an alternative location, during and after a disaster designated by county, state, or federal authorities. The goal is to reinstate business operations to the previous level pre-disaster, as quickly and economically as possible.

All personnel and volunteers will be expected to perform according to the professional expectations of them as counselors, management, Board of Directors, contract labor, and volunteers. It is imperative to ensure the continued safety of all involved and the continued quality operations of the IMAGINE Children's Health Center.
